Additional Housing

If travel plans dictate a need for an extended stay, additional nights of housing are available for an additional fee for the following nights: Friday, June 23; Sunday, June 25; and Saturday, July 1. Additional housing is \$28 per night; an additional \$20 change fee will be added for changes made after May 20. (Please note: if your student is participating in both Leadership Weekend and full week Summer Symposium, housing on Sunday night, June 25 is already included in your Symposium fees).

Arrival Day: Registration and Opening Sessions on June 24 and June 26

Camp registration will be open from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, June 24 for Leadership Weekend and Monday, June 26 for Full Week Symposium. Please consult the Student Check In/Out Info document for more details.

Opening Session for Leadership Weekend will begin promptly at 1 p.m. on June 24 in Pruis Hall. Opening Session for Full Week Symposium will begin promptly at 1 p.m. on June 26 in Emens Auditorium. We invite all parents to attend Opening Sessions. Directly following the Full Week Symposium Opening Session, there will be a special Parent Session that will begin at approximately 2:00 p.m. (location TBD)

Departure Day: Final Performances on July 1

All Final Performances are free and open to all parents and family members who wish to attend. They will begin at 9 a.m. and conclude at approximately 3 p.m. on Saturday, July 1. The Symposium concludes immediately after the final performances.

Family members are also encouraged to attend the Parent Breakfast from 6:30 to 8 a.m., Parents Session from 8:15 to 8:45 a.m., and Family Day Picnic from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Dorm checkout will begin after the performances have been completed. A limited number of tickets will be available on site, so we encourage parents and families to order them in advance.

Please note that all students are required to stay until 3 p.m. for the conclusion of the final performances regardless of what track they are participating in. Exceptions will be made for students who turn in an Early Departure Form (completed and signed by a parent/guardian) at check-in at the beginning of camp.
