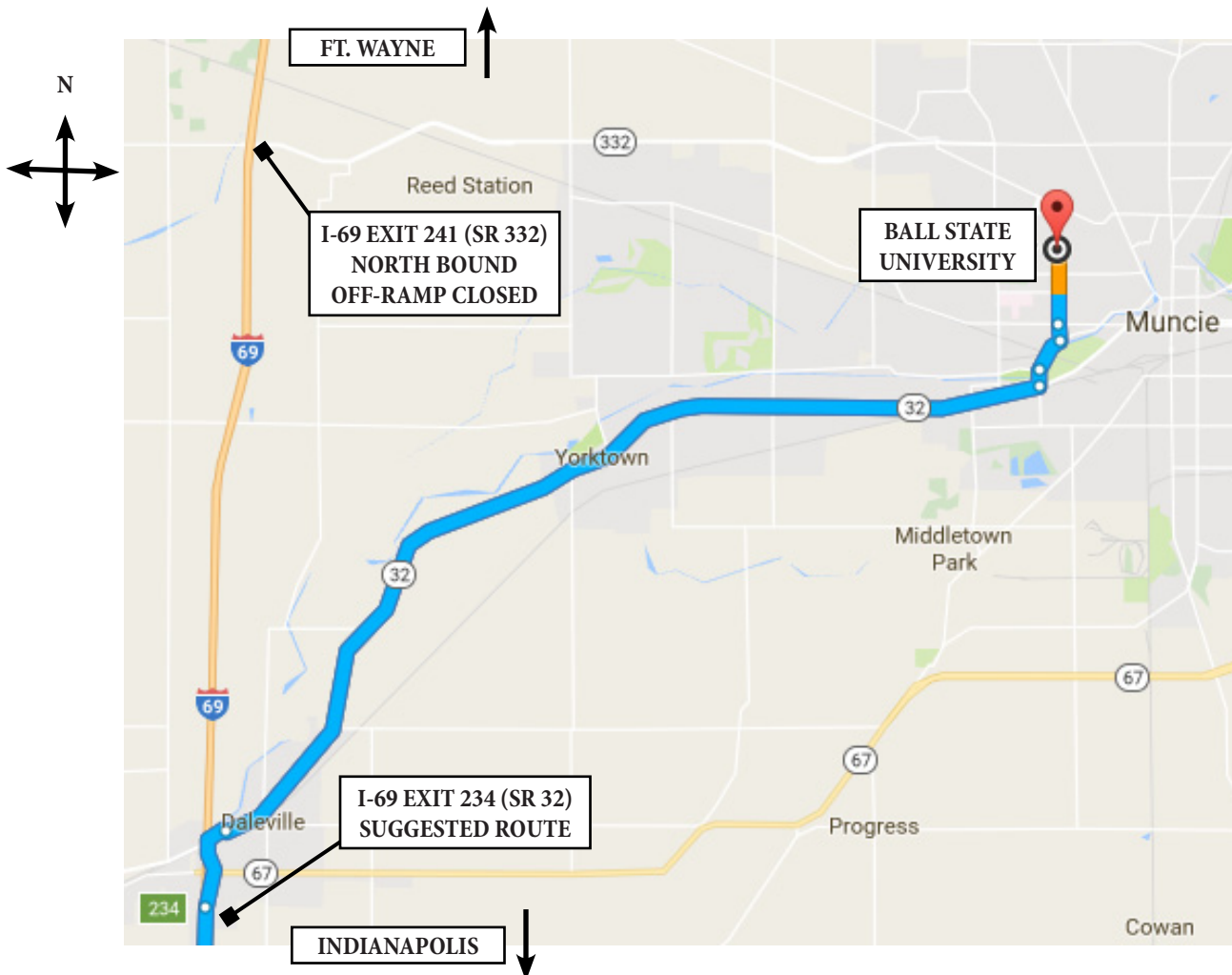


Exit 241 on I-69 has recently undergone a construction project that has temporarily closed the exit ramp going north-bound on the interstate. Contractors expect the ramp to be closed through the duration of Summer Symposium. Please find suggested driving directions and an accompanying map below.
 (Note: Exit 241 may still be used as on on and off ramp for south-bound traffic)



Suggested directions from the South (Indianapolis):

Take I-69 North to exit 234 for Anderson/Muncie (Indiana State Road 32). At the bottom of the ramp, continue driving through the traffic light and follow signs for SR 32. At the next stop sign, turn left to stay on SR 32 East. Follow SR 32 for 10 miles through Yorktown. After passing The End Zone Bar & Grill on your left, turn left onto Nicholls Ave., cross the bridge and take your next right onto White River Blvd. Follow White River Blvd. for approximately half a mile and turn left onto McKinley Ave. McKinley Ave is the main road that runs through the center of campus; after passing the Ball State bell tower, take your next right onto Neely Ave. The road to access Park, Baker, and Klipple Halls is on the right across the street from the Ball State Health Center. Kinghorn Hall is past the Health Center on the left. For Studebaker West and DeHority Halls, continue along Neeley Ave. and turn right onto New York Ave. The parking lot entrance is on the immediate right off of New York St. Studebaker West will be on your right; continue to follow the parking lot to the west and south to access Dehority Hall.
