CHECK-IN TIMES FOR EARLY ARRIVALS ON FRIDAY AND SUNDAY

Early check-in times on Friday, June 22 (prior to Leadership Weekend) and Sunday, June 24 (prior to Full Week Summer Symposium) is from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. at your designated dormitory. If you are expecting to arrive after 11:00 p.m., please call the Music for All 24-Hour Event Hotline at 877-643-6043 and notify us. A Music for All or Ball State University representative will meet you in the lobby of your assigned dormitory to check you in and give you your key.

MUSIC FOR ALL SPONSORED ACTIVITY ON FRIDAY AND SUNDAY

Upon arriving to campus, please report immediately to your assigned dorm to check into your room. Please also make sure to pick up information from the desk regarding the evening sponsored activity. **A sponsored activity will be held both Friday and Sunday night for early arriving participants at 6:00 p.m. at Cardinal Lanes Bowling Alley in the Student Center.** Dinner will be provided and you may use the time to bowl, play board games, watch movies, or hangout with friends and meet other campers!

All students must check in with Music for All staff members at the sponsored activity at 6:00 p.m. Exceptions will be made for students being supervised by their parents, guardians, or directors – in these instances, we ask that these parents, guardians, or directors check in with Music for All staff at the sponsored activity or call headquarters at 877.643.6043 to notify of such arrangements. Students who arrive on campus after 6:00 p.m. but before 9:00 p.m. are expected to report to the activity as soon as possible after checking into their dorm. The activity will end at 10:00 p.m. and all students will walk back as a group to their dorms before their floor meeting at 10:30 p.m. with their SWAGs.

SATURDAY MORNING REGISTRATION FOR FRIDAY EARLY ARRIVALS (LEADERSHIP WEEKEND EXPERIENCE)

Leadership Weekend Registration occurs between 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 23 at the Field Sports Building in the Student Recreation Center. Registration will take approximately 30 minutes, so early check-in is recommended. At Registration, you will receive your meal card for the week which will allow you to eat breakfast and lunch on Saturday before Opening Session. The Opening Session for Leadership Weekend Experience will begin promptly at 1:00 p.m. in Pruis Hall. If you are continuing on for the weeklong Symposium, you **do not** need to re-register on Monday, however you are still required to participate in your track's placement hearings, if applicable (see next page).

MONDAY MORNING REGISTRATION FOR SUNDAY EARLY ARRIVALS (FULL WEEK SUMMER SYMPOSIUM)

Symposium registration occurs between 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. on Monday, June 25 at the Field Sports Building in the Student Recreation Center. Registration will take approximately 30 minutes, so early check-in is recommended. At Registration, you will receive your meal card for the week which will allow you to eat breakfast and lunch on Monday before Opening Session. Please also plan on making time to participate in your track's placement hearings, if applicable (see next page). The Opening Session for Summer Symposium will begin promptly at 1:00 p.m. in Emens Auditorium.

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PLEASE NOTE: Students in the Color Guard, Concert Band, Orchestra, Jazz Band, and Middle School Concert Band divisions require placement hearings that will occur on Monday morning prior to Opening Session. Make sure you leave enough time to register AND complete your hearing prior to the Opening Session. Refer to your weekly schedule that you will receive at check-in for building and room information.

LATE DEPARTURES ON SUNDAY, JULY 1:

Camp officially ends at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 30. For students who have arranged for a late departure, **a sponsored activity will take place that evening at 6:00 p.m. in Room 175 of the Arts & Journalism Building (adjacent to the Atrium and Music for All Headquarters).** Dinner will be provided and you may use the time to watch movies, play board games, or hangout with friends and meet other campers!

All late departure students must check in with Music for All staff members at the sponsored activity at 6:00 p.m.

Exceptions will be made for students being supervised by their parents, guardians, or directors – in these instances, we ask that these parents, guardians, or directors check in with Music for All staff at the sponsored activity or call headquarters at 877.643.6043 to notify of such arrangements. The activity will end at 10:00 p.m. and all students will walk back as a group to their dorms before their floor meeting at 10:30 p.m. with their SWAGs. **On Sunday morning, July 1, breakfast is on your own and you must check out of your dormitory by 9:00 a.m.** A key drop will be available should your dormitory's front desk not be open when you check out. If you are taking a departure shuttle, please refer to the Airport Shuttle Information document for more details.
