



MEAL CARDS & PROCEDURES FOR STUDENTS

All Leadership and full-week Symposium campers will be given a meal card to be swiped in the dining halls during designated meal periods. Meal cards are preloaded with a set amount of money for each meal period. Students will be using dining halls that are “all you care to eat” and “a la carte.” Campers that wish to purchase “a la carte” items above and beyond the amount of money on the meal card will be allowed to do so by paying with cash or credit/debit card. Some campers choose to bring cash or a pre-paid debit/credit card for these instances. Please note that the amount of money loaded onto the meal card will purchase an adequate meal for either a student or adult camper.

Breakfast - \$5.35

Lunch - \$9.42

Dinner - \$9.42

* you may only swipe your card once per each mealtime

LOST ROOM KEYS & MEAL CARDS:

At registration, students will receive a key, which will allow them access to their dormitory for the duration of camp, as well as a meal card for access into the dining halls. If, at any time, their key or meal card is lost or stolen, they must find a SWAG (camp counselor) or go to SWAG Headquarters located in Park Hall to fill out acknowledgement of responsibility for the charge. Please be sure your child is aware of this policy.

Campers will be charged \$60 for a new room key and \$5 for a new meal card. If your child does not have the necessary funds with them (cash, check, or credit card), we will contact you, their parent(s) or guardian(s), for payment. A new key and/or meal card will not be issued without you or your child’s knowledge.

Leadership Weekend Experience & Full Week Summer Symposium Campers:

- Additional meals provided for Friday early arrival participants: Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast and lunch
- If you do not pay for an early arrival, it is recommended you bring money to buy lunch at one of the campus dining halls prior to Opening Session

Summer Symposium ONLY Campers:

- Dinner Monday, June 25 – Lunch Saturday, June 30 (includes picnics on Friday evening and Saturday afternoon)
- Additional meals provided for Sunday early arrival participants: Sunday dinner, Monday breakfast and lunch
- If you do not pay for an early arrival, it is recommended you bring money to buy lunch at one of the campus dining halls prior to Opening Session

Leadership Weekend Experience ONLY Campers:

- Dinner Saturday, June 23 – Lunch Monday, June 25
- Additional meals provided for early Friday early arrival participants: Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast and lunch
- If you do not pay for an early arrival, it is recommended you bring money to buy lunch at one of the campus dining halls prior to Opening Session

MEAL LOCATIONS & TIMES:

Meal locations and times will be included in every participant’s daily schedule, as well as on the detailed Symposium Campus Map.

FOR PARTICIPANTS WITH FOOD ALLERGIES:

Participants with food allergies must self-identify at meal times. All dining halls will have marked stations for participants with food allergies with staff that can prepare special meals on request to fit a specific allergy or need. Should students have any questions during camp, they may talk to their SWAG, a camp nurse, or a Ball State University Dining staff member.
