DIRECTIONS TO BALL STATE UNIVERSITY:

NOTE: McKinley Ave. will be closed on campus between Bethel Ave. and Neely Ave. due to construction

From the north: Take I-69 S to Exit 241 for Highway 332 (Frankton/Muncie). Turn left onto Highway 332 and follow for approximately 8 miles to the fourth stop light at Tillotson Ave. Turn right on Tillotson Ave. and follow it approximately 1.5 miles to Riverside Ave. Turn left onto Riverside Ave. and follow for half a mile until you reach the stop light at the center of campus. PLEASE REFER TO THE DIRECTIONS FOR YOUR SPECIFIC DORMITORY LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS PAGE.

From the south: Take I-65 N to I-465 East. Follow I-465 East, which will become I-465 North, to Exit 37 for I-69 North. Take I-69 N to Exit 241 for Highway 332 (Frankton/Muncie). Turn right onto Highway 332 and follow for approximately 8 miles to the fourth stop light at Tillotson Ave. Turn right on Tillotson Ave. and follow it approximately 1.5 miles to Riverside Ave. Turn left onto Riverside Ave. and follow for half a mile until you reach the stop light at the center of campus. From the east: Take I-70 West toward Richmond, Indiana. Take exit 149B for US 35 North toward Muncie, Indiana. After 33 miles, stay left and follow signs to Muncie/Ball State University via E. 29th St. Follow E. 29th St. for 1.5 miles and turn left onto Madison St. Follow Madison St. for 2 miles and turn left onto Main St. Follow Main St. for a mile (road turns into Jackson St.), turn right onto McKinley Ave, and follow for half a mile until you reach the stop light at the center of campus. From the west: Take I-70 East, through Indianapolis to Exit 89 for I-465 on the east side of town. Take I-465 North to I-69 North. Take I-69 S to Exit 241 for Highway 332 (Frankton/Muncie). Turn left onto Highway 332 and follow for approximately 8 miles to the fourth stop light at Tillotson Ave. Turn right on Tillotson Ave. and follow it approximately 1.5 miles to Riverside Ave. Turn left onto Riverside Ave. and follow for half a mile until you reach the stop light at the center of campus. PLEASE REFER TO THE DIRECTIONS FOR YOUR SPECIFIC DORMITORY LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS PAGE.

Kinghorn Hall: Continue east on Riverside Ave. to New York Ave. At New York Ave. turn left, and take the next left onto Neely Ave. You will pass Kinghorn Hall and the Health Center on the right, and the entrance to the Kinghorn parking lot will be immediately past the Health Center. Follow the drive to the parking lot on the north end of the building.

DeHority and Studebaker West Halls: Continue east on Riverside Ave. through the traffic light. After passing Emens Auditorium and Woodworth Complex on the left, turn left on the drive across from the BSU Christian Campus House. Dehority Hall will be immediately on your left; continue to follow the drive lot to the north and east to access the Studebaker West complex.

Baker, Klipple, and Park Halls: Continue east on Riverside Ave. through the traffic light. After passing Emens Auditorium on the left, turn left on the drive across from Martin St. Follow the drive to access the parking garage. The garage is situated west of Park and south of the Noyer Complex, which contains Baker and Klipple Halls.

Johnson Complex: Continue east on Riverside Ave. At the intersection of McKinley, turn left and drive north. At the next light, turn left onto Petty Rd. After passing the parking lot on the right, turn right on the access road. The access road passes behind LaFollette Hall on the right; the Johnson Complex is located at the end of the access road.

*Campers who drive themselves will receive a parking pass and instructions at their dormitory check-in, and may be instructed to move their car to a different location for the duration of the week. Student residential campers that drive themselves must turn in their car keys to SWAGs at check-in and will receive them again before checking out at the end of the week.
