## **DIRECTIONS TO BALL STATE UNIVERSITY:**

From the north: Take I-69 S to Exit 241 for Highway 332 (Frankton/Muncie). Turn left onto Highway 332 and follow for approximately 8 miles to the fourth stop light at Tillotson Ave. Turn right on Tillotson Ave. You should see the football stadium on your left; at the next light turn left onto Bethel Ave. After passing Northside Middle School on the left, turn right at the next light onto McKinley Ave. PLEASE REFER TO THE DIRECTIONS TO YOUR SPECIFIC DORMITORY AND REGISTRATION LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS PAGE.

From the south: Take I-65 N to I-465 East. Follow I-465 East, which will become I-465 North, to Exit 37 for I-69 North. Take I-69 to Highway 32, Exit 234 (Anderson/Muncie). At the bottom of the ramp, continue driving through the traffic light and follow signs for SR 32. At the next stop sign, turn left to stay on SR 32 East. Follow SR 32 for 10 miles through Yorktown. After passing The End Zone Bar & Grill on your left, turn left onto Nicholls Ave., cross the bridge and take your next right onto White River Blvd. Follow White River Blvd. for approximately half a mile and turn left onto McKinley Ave. McKinley Ave. is the main road that runs through the center of campus; after passing the Ball State bell tower, take your next right onto Neely Ave. PLEASE REFER TO THE DIRECTIONS TO YOUR SPECIFIC DORMITORY AND REGISTRATION LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS PAGE.

From the east: Take I-70 West toward Richmond, Indiana. Take exit 149B for US 35 North toward Muncie, Indiana. After 33 miles, take the exit for Highways 67 and 35 North. Follow the bypass to the McGalliard Rd. exit. Turn left onto McGalliard Rd. and follow for approximately 4 miles to Tillotson Ave. Turn left on Tillotson Ave. You should see the football stadium on your left; at the next light turn left onto Bethel Ave. After passing Northside Middle School on the left, turn right at the next light onto McKinley Ave. PLEASE REFER TO THE DIRECTIONS TO YOUR SPECIFIC DORMITORY AND REGISTRATION LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS PAGE.

From the west: Take I-70 East, through Indianapolis to Exit 89 for I-465 on the east side of town. Take I-465 North to I-69 North. Take I-69 to Highway 32, Exit 234 (Anderson/Muncie). At the bottom of the ramp, continue driving through the traffic light and follow signs for SR 32. At the next stop sign, turn left to stay on SR 32 East. Follow SR 32 for 10 miles through Yorktown. After passing The End Zone Bar & Grill on your left, turn left onto Nicholls Ave., cross the bridge and take your next right onto White River Blvd. Follow White River Blvd. for approximately half a mile and turn left onto McKinley Ave. McKinley Ave. is the main road that runs through the center of campus; after passing the Ball State bell tower, take your next right onto Neely Ave. PLEASE REFER TO THE DIRECTIONS TO YOUR SPECIFIC DORMITORY AND REGISTRATION LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS PAGE.

Registration: From Bethel Ave, you will enter on the road shown on the map below. Parking for registration will be in Lot C9.

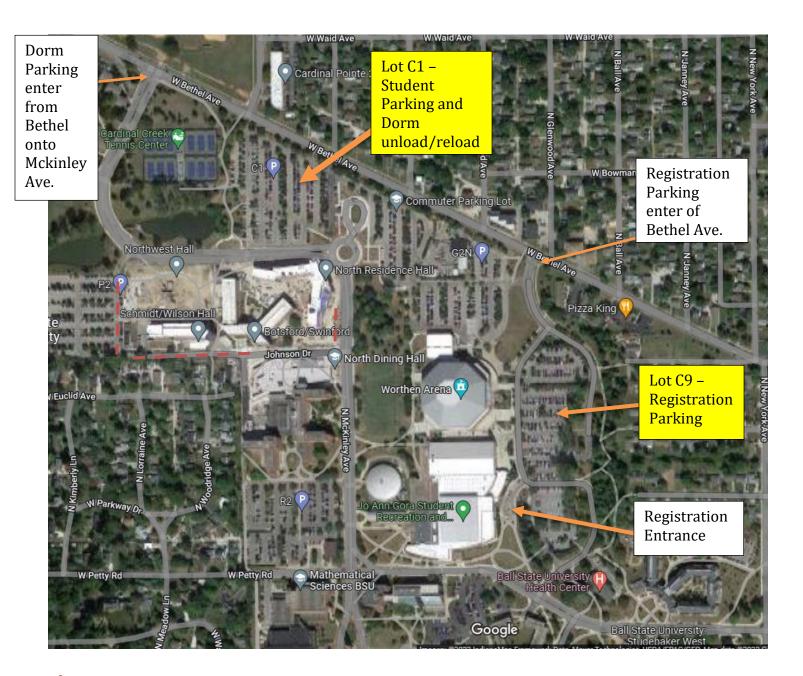
## **DORMITORY DIRECTIONS:**

**Kinghorn Hall (Directors):** Turn east at the traffic light, towards the Student Recreation Center, onto Neely Avenue. The entrance to the Kinghorn parking lot will be on your left. Kinghorn Hall is further east on Neely Ave.; park and enter the building on the north.

Schmidt/Wilson Hall (Male): Please park in Lot C1 to unload/reload into the dorm. See map below for reference.

North Residence Hall (Beyerl -Female): Please park in Lot C1 to unload/reload into the dorm. See map below for reference.

\*Commuter students will receive parking passes at Camp check-in. All other students will receive parking passes when they check-in to the dormitory, but will have to turn their car keys into with MFA staff for the duration of camp.
